ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Christian Outreach Uplifted New Tribes, Rangareddy District, Andhra Pradesh has submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to St.John's College of Education, Agape Centre, Chengicherla Village, Boduppall Post, Ghatkesar Mandal, Rangareddy District-500039, Andhra Pradesh for Secondary(B.Ed) course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (Hundred) Students.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, the Committee is satisfied that the institution fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, Infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratories etc for running the programme and has appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

2. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to St.John's College of Education, Agape Centre, Chengicherla Village, Boduppall Post, Ghatkesar Mandal, Rangareddy District-500039, Andhra Pradesh for conducting Secondary(B.Ed) course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100(Hundred) students under clause 7(12) of Regulations dated.13.01.2006. This order of recognition shall be prospective and take effect from the date of issue of this order, subject to fulfillment of the following:

- i) The Institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.
- ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- iii) The institution will ensure that Principal and Seven faculty members duly approved by the affiliating University are in position for an intake of 100 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / bodies, State Government etc., as applicable.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. The institution shall maintain & update the Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations.
7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

GENERAL CONDITIONS TO BE FULFILLED BY ALL COLLEGES :

1. That they should appoint teaching staff @ 1:12 through duly constituted selection committee as per OU norms, associating the University Nominee on the Selection Committee and Subject Expert representing all Methodologies and obtain the Renewal/approval of the Registrar, OU, for the existing/New staff at the beginning of the academic year whenever required;
2. They should run the course in two sections of (50) each where the accommodation for (100) students is not available;
3. As per NCTE norms the Management has to shift the College to its own premises within (3) academic years from the date of establishment.
4. To provide spacious rooms for classes and laboratories and separate toilets for boys and girls as suggested by the Inspection Committee;
5. Consolidated attendance statement is to be prepared every year and submit to the University;
6. It is made clear to all the colleges that if the above conditions are not fulfilled by the college(s) within the stipulated time, such college(s) will be disaffiliated under intimation to NCTE/State Government.
7. To appoint a qualified librarian;
8. Attendance register and teaching diaries are to be maintained properly. Attendance to be marked in the class room only.
9. College should follow OU almanac strictly.
